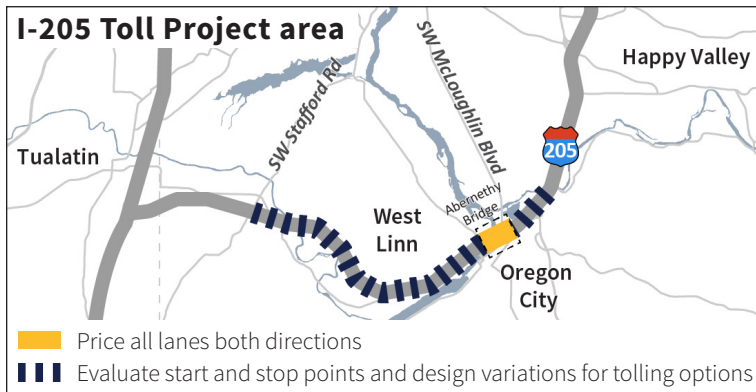


Your Input Needed to Improve I-205 Travel

Public comment period open through Sept. 16



Tolls are one tool the Oregon Department of Transportation is considering to improve our transportation system. This project would toll all lanes of I-205 at or near the Abernethy Bridge to both raise revenue for planned seismic upgrades and transportation improvements and manage congestion between Stafford Road and OR 213.

We are evaluating five options where tolls could start and stop -- and how the different options could pay for roadway improvements along the I-205 corridor and manage congestion.

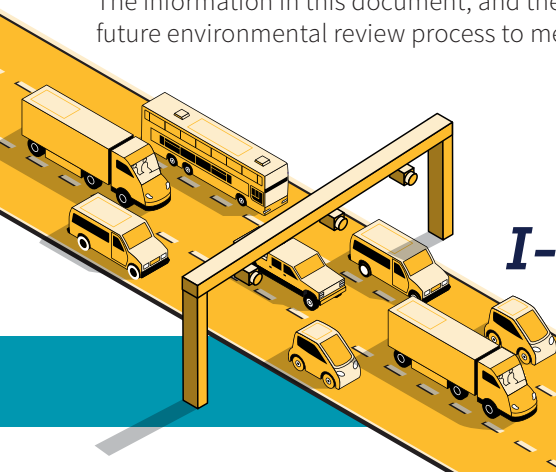
